CLEANING YOUR PIANO

Remember that dust will scratch if wiped with a dry cloth. Try to use a feather duster or a slightly damp soft cotton cloth. Do not use furniture polish or other cleaning products that contain silicone as they may affect the finish. If you wish to remove fine scratches or marks, only use a high quality cream polish. For example, 'BMW Autopolitur' car polish or '3M Hand Glaze'. Please remember these are slightly abrasive, so only use rarely and very sparingly. Clean the white keys with a slightly damp white cotton cloth and water (coloured cloths may stain the keys). You can slightly lift the white keys (approximately 2mm) to reach them properly for cleaning. Try to use a different cloth for the black keys to prevent the black polish from staining the white keys.
